

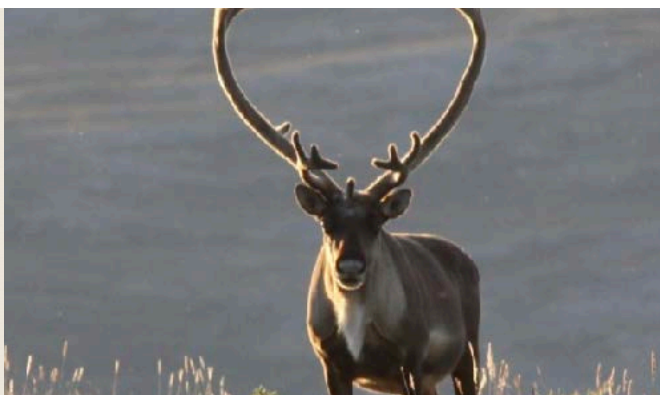
Facilities

The course is going to take place at Greenland Representation, Strandgade 91, 3th Floor, 1401 Copenhagen.

We will provide reservation of hotel rooms if sleepovers will be necessary in relation to the participation of the course. The hotel stay, treat (coffee, tea, water, lunch, cake and fruit) will be included in the price.


